WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP

- Typically, a 3-5 Year Program
- Apprentices earn while they learn
- Little to no cost to the apprentice
- Apprentices Typically earn College Credit
- Members of a Labor Union
- Members can travel with a Journeyman card

BENEFITS OF A CAREER IN THE TRADES

- Competitive union bargained salary
- Top Line health Care
- Great Retirement
- Other fringes such as annuities or international pensions

HOW TO BECOME AN APPRENTICE

- Application through an apprenticeship JAC

Application is made during hiring timeframes through the year. The JAC approved the apprentice.

- Letter of Intent to Hire

Contractor provides a letter of intent to hire the apprentice. The apprentice enters the program.
