APPRENTICE OPPORTUNITIES

The Roofers Local #71 Joint Apprenticeship Program will be accepting applications for a new class of Roofers. Application forms are available to be picked up at the office of the Roofers Joint Apprenticeship Committee located in the offices of the Builders Association of Eastern OH & Western PA at the following address:

Applicants must include the following items with their application:

- A. Military Service Certificate of Completion (DD-214) (if applicable)**
- B. Valid Driver's License or Identification**

Completed applications must be hand delivered or mailed to the above location.

To be considered for this class to be held in February **applications will be accepted year round.**

The following is the progression of wages for Roofer Apprentices during the Apprenticeship Program:

1 st year Roofers Apprentice:	\$19.70 per hour + \$3.27 in benefits
2 nd year Roofers Apprentice:	\$21.22 per hour + \$9.71 in benefits
3 rd year Roofers Apprentice:	\$24.25 per hour + \$10.46 in benefits
4 th year Roofers Apprentice:	\$27.28 per hour + \$18.21 in benefits

Upon completion of the 4 year apprenticeship program, the current pay rate for Journeymen Roofers is **\$30.31** per hour with an additional **\$19.61** in benefits (i.e. Pension & Medical)

Basic Qualifications:

1. At least 18 years of age
2. Physically capable of performing work of the trade
3. Be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen & physical

An in-person interview is part of the apprentice selection process. Selection of apprentices under this program shall be made on the basis of qualification alone and all applicants will be afforded equal opportunity under these standards without regard to race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, disability, genetic information, age, or national origin. This information is forwarded to you in compliance with the selection procedures of the training program, approved and registered by the Ohio State Apprenticeship Council.
